BPLOGIX SUCCESS STORY Medical Device Company Scales Publication Output with PubPro



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A global leader in medical device innovation, renowned for its transformative work in neuromodulation and cardiac surgery, has always focused on publishing scientific evidence to support clinical decision making.

An increase in the number of studies, focus on global use and patient populations, and working with providers in established and emerging markets created a critical challenge: managing and scaling its publication processes to keep pace with demand.

Publication management challenges

Before PubPro, the publication process relied heavily on manual workflows to ensure adherence to the latest Good Publication Practices (GPP2022).¹ Each publication required multiple emails to gather reviews and approvals, creating inefficiencies and increasing the potential for errors. The process also did not allow reviewers or authors to see other's comments and suggestions, which sometimes required additional dialogue to resolve.

This historical method strained internal resources, requiring team members to spend significant time chasing approvals and consolidating feedback. Beyond the time-consuming nature of the process, manually following up on approvals can place team members in the uncomfortable position of holding others accountable, creating interpersonal tension, and disrupting collaboration.

"Receiving multiple follow-up emails to complete a review can sometimes impact working relationships," the Global Publication Director explained. "Software helps mitigate that by depersonalizing reminders and enabling people to complete reviews more efficiently on their own time."

As the volume of publications grew, these inefficiencies became even more pronounced, underscoring the limitations of manual processes: "We were going from maybe 3 or 4 publications a year to 16. Many companies aren't increasing headcounts to compensate for this. It falls on the individual, or small group, and manual processes can hinder performance and outcomes."

Faced with rising demands and inefficiencies, the company needed a modern, adaptable solution. With over 30 years of experience in publication management, the publication director was tasked with finding a way to streamline and "future-proof" their operations.
